

Stafford Conservation Commission members present: Paul Pearson, Arlene Avery, Kitty Schooley, Brian Zawodniak—three community volunteers also present including Nancy Mattesen, Maryann Gianantoni, and Maureen Griffith. Dr. Neil Hoss present.

- Survey on Stafford Conservation Committee's Facebook page to gauge interest for disc golf. Arlene mentioned an 'old fashioned' paper survey to also gauge interest. Hard copies at the town library, town hall, other locations. Have members at the Post Office to get public opinion. Draft of survey will be worked on.
- Maps available at CROG.org to help plan out possible sites in town for disc golf. Topographic information also provided. Google maps also a potential help in the planning process.
- Visitation Hyde Park and Olympic 1st—March 14th—6:30 PM. Meet at the monument.
- Create a checklist for each site—evaluate each site equally and fairly. Photographic evidence will be taken at each site. Checklist will be developed and sent to members for evaluation and comment prior to first visit. Dr. Hoss will also get a copy of the checklist.
- Explore private land USE for disc golf *instead* of donating land. We will first explore the old Stafford Golf Course.
- Arlene has contacted Tolland and Vernon Park and Rec departments as well as Promfret to gather information about disc golf. Those minutes are available on line on the town website from the Stafford Conservation Committee's February 13, 2018 special meeting.
- We will reach out to the Stafford Recreation Commission as well to let them know what the Stafford Disc Golf Committee is doing. We will also tell the Hyde Park Commission about our plans. Planning and Zoning will also be in the loop.
- At our next meeting, we will talk more about the school campus potential for a disc golf course. Drone footage on a weekend before spring greenery comes out.
- Funding routes will be explored in future.
